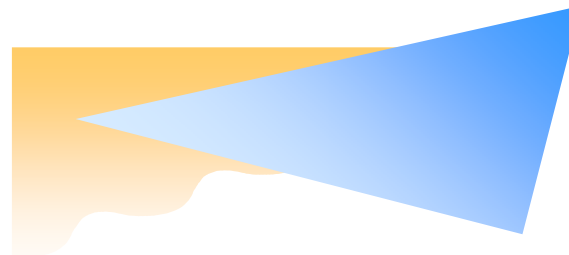
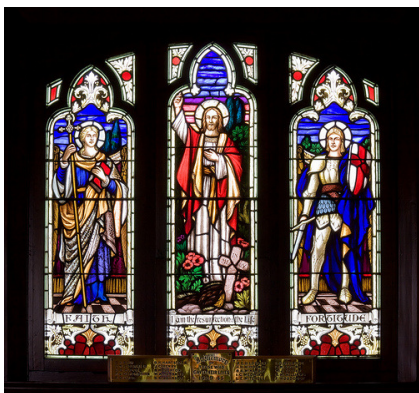

Organ & Sound

An organist is available to play our magnificent Croft pipe organ at your wedding.

A sound technician is necessary to attend to the microphones and play CDs or taped music.

Other arrangements may be discussed with the Minister.

Flowers

The artificial flowers which the Church can provide are suitable for display in the Church and the Church foyer.

The cost for their use is \$25.

If you would like to use fresh flowers, the supply and arrangement of them are your responsibility and the arrangements must remain in the Church for the Sunday service.

Charges

Non-Parishioners:

Church \$400-00

(The \$400 includes 1½ hours for the church service and 1 hour for the rehearsal. All time exceeding this to be charged at \$50 per hour)

Organist \$90-00

Sound Technician \$75-00

Minister suggested donation \$200-00

A 30% deposit is payable to the Church Office upon confirmation by the Minister of your booking.

Balance is payable 3 weeks prior to the date of the wedding.

The copy of Particulars of Marriage that you collect from the Marriage Registrar prior to marrying must be left at the Church office one week prior to the date of the wedding.
