Earthquake Strengthening – Stage 2

The engineering design plans for the second (and final) stage of works, to bring the church up to a minimum of 67%NBS, have been completed. We are currently waiting upon receiving both revised costings from the quantity surveyor, and approval from Hamilton City Council to proceed. Once approved, we should be able to put the work up for tender from suitable contractors.

We were fortunate to have Stage 1 come in below budget. If we allow for a 15% increase on the original budget for both stages, the cost for Stage 2 is estimated to be about \$215,000 plus GST. As we currently have just under \$115,000 cash set aside specifically tagged for this purpose, that would leave about \$100,000 still to be raised.

As it is now Christmas, our final 'push' to raise the balance will start in earnest in the new year. However, any donations tagged for this purpose are most welcome at any time.
