

Dr. Emma Barker-Clarke is a senior trainer for Shine (Safer Homes in New Zealand Everyday) and is a trustee board member for Rape Prevention Education. She specialises in family and sexual violence prevention and safer response practices, with extensive experience in probation and youth justice. Emma's MSc in Criminology research focused on supporting young people experiencing violence in intimate relationships, which became the foundation for her prevention work. In 2024, she earned her PhD in Sociology/Criminology from the University of Auckland, where her research focused on technology-facilitated sexual violence.
