

Vicki Jones is a Waikato artist who discovered printmaking after attending a 2022 harakeke papermaking workshop with Whanganui printmaker Marty Vreede. Marty shared the diverse world of printmaking and Vicki has enjoyed exploring that diversity ever since, particularly through the excellent tutoring offered by the Waikato Society of Arts. Her printmaking also draws on her previous work in watercolour, coloured pencil and botanical art.

Vicki mostly works within the Intaglio family of printmaking techniques, especially etching with its ability to show fine detail and line work. Nature forms the basis of much of her work, but she also appreciates the role of printmaking in addressing social issues.

Vicki is a member of Waikato Society of Arts, the Print Council of Aotearoa New Zealand (PCANZ), and the Botanical Art Society of New Zealand (BASNZ). She enjoys her role as PCANZ Hamilton representative.

Molly\* is a young mother who recently spent several weeks by her baby's side in the neonatal unit. Her baby was suffering from withdrawal, and Molly was

confronting the impact of her past struggles with drug addiction. Through the quiet, steady support of hospital chaplain Rosemary, she found comfort, courage, and hope for a new beginning.
